TEAM REGISTRATION FEES: All age divisions: \$500 Per Team.

RULES OF COMPETITION:

NBSL events will be played under FIFA rules, below are guidelines for play. This manual will be distributed to all coaches and referees. If any disputes occur the League Organizing Committee will have the final say.

The rules of beach soccer are based on the Laws of the Game of association football, with several modifications.

Laws of the Game Overview

- **Pitch:**
 - 35-37m in length and 26-28m in width
 - Flags mark edge of penalty area and halfway line
- **Team:**
 - 6 players of each team
 - Unlimited (rolling) substitutions
 - Maximum of 12 in matchday squad
- **Game:**
 - 3 period, each of 12 minutes
 - No draws in beach soccer
 - 3 minutes of Extra Time
 - Penalties (3 each – followed by Sudden Death)
 - Win in Normal Time is worth 3 points
 - Win in Extra Time is worth 2 points
 - Win on Penalties is worth 1 point
 - A direct freekick is awarded for every foul
 - Fouled player should take the shot
 - No offsides
 - No walls (blocking freekicks)
 - No footwear with the exception of socks
 - Throw-ins taken with hands or feet
 - Headers are allowed in beach soccer

EQUIPMENT:

Each team must provide the complete uniform (jersey and short) to the players. All players must wear the same color to distinguish themselves from other teams. Shoes and shin guards are not allowed. Players are allowed to wear socks to protect their feet from the heat.

POINTS AND TIEBREAKERS:

Point system during group stage is as follows:

- Win in normal time is worth 3 points
- Win in extra point is worth 2 points
- Win on Penalties is worth 1 point

In the event of a tiebreaker following group stage the following tiebreak criteria will apply:

- Total number of points
- If still tied – Head to head result
- Total goal differential to a maximum/minimum of +/- 5 per game.
- If still tied – Goals in favor
- If still tied – Goals against
- If still tied – A series of 3 penalty shots from the penalty spot

ROSTERS: Coaches please fill out the attached NBSL event roster or submit your FYSA roster by email by Friday at 5PM.

HYDRATION: Player safety is a top priority here at NBSL, very important each player brings plenty of water throughout the day.

AWARDS: Trophy Awards are presented to the 1st place and medals for the 2nd place in each Division.
